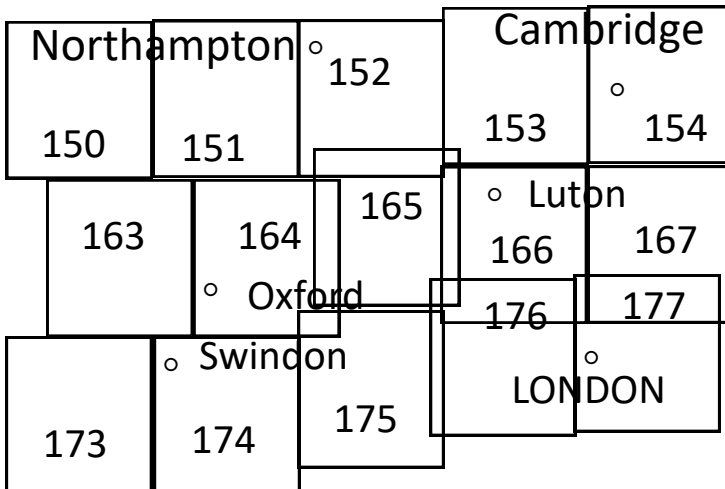

## **Information on District Association (DA) Camping**

On your membership card you will find details of the local group or District Association you are attached to which is dictated by home your address. You can always co-opt into another DA if you wish, all you need to do is contact the secretary of the DA you wish to join. You will also find details of any section that you have subscribed to as well. At least once a year, the secretaries details of all the DA,s, Sections and Region are published in the Camping and Caravanning Magazine if you want more details, although details of our local secretaries can be found in this publication but may be subject to change at the AGM's which are held between February and May.

Please note that you are not restricted to camping with just the DA on your card as you can camp at any DA, Section or Regional meet. These meets are known as five day meets and are only open to members, just remember that you will always need to show your membership cards at these meets.

Some DA's, Sections and Regions also operate Temporary Holiday Sites (THS) in different areas throughout the country at varying times of year and for its members. These meets are intended to offer affordable camping which is open to all members, but members only can camp but non members can join the Club at these meets. At DA meets, only members can camp at these meets and you are unable to join the Club at these meets.

Please note however, that some of these meets only offer minimal facilities and you will may need to bring your own sanitary equipment (toilets) with you and showers may not be available but most modern caravans have toilets and showers on board and these facilities are available to purchase for tent campers.

When camping at any of these meets, you should always ensure that there is a 6.0m space between you and your neighbour and the meet stewards will always give you guidance on this matter if you are not sure.

Please also remember that the speed limit when driving on a DA or THS meet is 5mph and no learner drivers are allowed.

It is also highly recommended that you place a fire bucket outside your unit in case of an emergency.

If you want more information on these meets please contact the secretary of the DA you are attached to as per your membership card.
